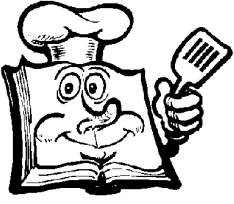


Blokes and Sheds Breakfast

Who are Greg and Sandra Lewis?

We are pleased to have Greg and Sandra Lewis sharing in our worship and activities this month. Greg and Sandra are missionaries with Pioneers of Australia who served in Yei, southern Sudan from 2005 until 2008. After a short period of home assignment Greg completed theological studies at Perth Bible College and Sandra completed a residential course on healing and deliverance ministries with Ellel Ministries. They are now preparing to return to Africa in April 2010.



Greg and Sandra are both originally from Western Australia, but spent 11 years in country Queensland, where Greg worked as an associate lecturer at the University of Queensland and Sandra worked in the day respite programme for a church based aged care provider. In their church, the Gatton Christian Life Centre, they ran an outreach home group for overseas students, and Sandra was also involved in the church worship team.

Greg and Sandra have a heart for building disciples in Africa, so that the lives of many African Christians will be changed and their communities transformed. Between 2005 and 2008 Greg was involved in radio ministry and Sandra was involved in Christian literature development and promoting prayer. When they return to Africa Greg and Sandra will be returning to their first love by establishing a programme of teaching/ training, mentoring and facilitating healing through prayer and counselling. This will meet some of the great need that the people have because of the trauma that they suffered during the long civil war.

Rostered Drivers Needed.

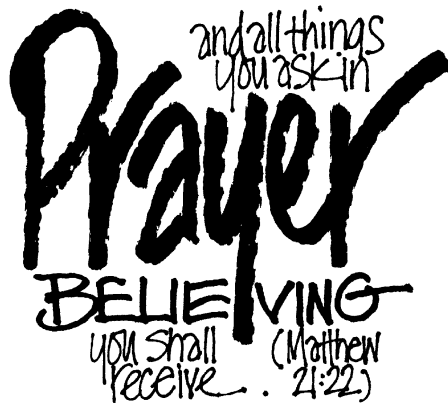
